FELLOWSHIP

Description:

Fellowship ministry aims to invite students into the CCM community by gathering them at various social activities and, in doing so, to help them grow closer to Christ and each other. Fellowship designs and hosts diverse social events/activities to encourage both Catholics and non-Catholics to try new things and to create a fun, open, comfortable environment where friendship can be forged.

Duties:

1) Events

- a) Coordinate and put on CCM's fellowship events throughout the year.
 - i) Holiday Parties, Super Bowl, Movie Night, Labor Day Cookout, etc.
 - 1) Holiday Parties that take place at Tuesday Night Dinner (Christmas, Thanksgiving, etc.)
 - ii) Organize and oversee Intramural Sports participation, if the community desires it
- b) Collaborate with other campus organizations (BCM & Intervarsity) and other CCMs (Lynchburg, Liberty, UVA, etc.)

2) Men's/Women's Groups

- a) Schedule groups twice a month, balancing activities for both fellowship and formation
- b) Organize and work with staff to arrange speakers and topics to form men and women in respective groups
- c) Reach out to the men and women of Longwood and cultivate a space where they can grow in their Catholic faith and learn how to live out authentic masculinity and femininity respectively
- d) Provide snacks/desserts at appropriate gatherings

2) Tuesday Night Dinner

- a) Select and run a game/icebreaker at each TND
 - i) Update the Game/Icebreaker Document

3) Welcome Week

- a) All Leadership Team members will participate in and lead Welcome Week activities.

4) Administration

- a) Meetings
 - i) Attend all Leadership Team meetings unless significant circumstances intervene
 - ii) Attend Leadership Retreat
- b) Publicity
 - i) Be sure photos are taken at events and sent to the Communications Chair
